



#### Doing \*Worldwide Work \*While I'm in Japan!


Takumi Amino

I'm Takumi Amino, a web designer. I studied \*design at an art school after graduating from high school, and now I work for a website design company. I've made many websites in English for many kinds of \*clients, for example, shops, restaurants and hospitals. I've also made some websites in Japanese for foreign clients.

I think making English websites is a very \*effective way to \*connect with people around the world. Last year a \*manager of a kimono shop in Kyoto asked us to make an English website. Since we made a new one and put it on the Internet, more foreign people have seen the website and are now actually coming to the shop. And some people who live abroad send her e-mails and ask her to send kimonos to their countries. She said she feels happy because people who have never been to Japan are interested in kimonos by seeing the English website. I also feel happy to hear that.

Even Japanese people who can't use English can be web designers if they know a lot about design and computers, but they can only send information to people who understand Japanese. \*On the other hand, if you can use English, you can \*communicate directly with people around the world and connect with each other through the Internet. That means you have a chance to do worldwide work while you're in Japan! I think \*situations like this will also happen in many other jobs in the near future. So study English to make your future great!


